## **OnX Enterprise Solutions Named**

### **Vendor of the Year by MISA**

TORONTO, July 5, 2006 – **OnX Enterprise Solutions Inc., (TSX:ON), “OnX”**, a leading provider of IT services and outsourcing solutions, announces it has been named Vendor of the Year by the Municipal Information Systems Association (MISA) at its annual conference on June 6, 2006. The award was presented in recognition of the solution OnX designed, built and now operates for the Region of Durham, ON. In addition, the Region of Durham won the MISA award for Municipal Solution of the Year, being the OnX solution which has allowed the region to streamline the payment approval process for local builders, save interest costs and estimate future revenues more accurately.

The Region of Durham is experiencing tremendous growth in residential development throughout the eight municipalities of Ajax, Whitby, Pickering, Oshawa, Clarington, Uxbridge, Scugog and Brock. To support this growth, and the requirement of Bill 124 which requires the Region to support the developers with a maximum of 10 day turnaround process, the Region wanted to replace its manual process of submitting the Residential Development Charges Information form for local builders.

Once paid by the builder, the payment is forwarded to the regional finance office for allocation and record keeping. This process used to take 20-25 business days and, during this period, the status of the form was difficult to track. So, the Region turned to OnX to develop an electronic version of the form for builders and local administrative staff via the Web. OnX came up with an electronic form that is identical to the paper-based form, capturing all information related to new developments and construction. The process now takes 2 - 5 days, and allows the Region to estimate future revenues more accurately.

“The application provides an electronic capture and tracking of the form through an extensive workflow,” said Lasse Silegren, SVP & GM, Professional Services, OnX Enterprise Solutions Inc. “Once the charges for a form or series of forms are collected, the form is archived and stored for reference. Reports can be generated on forms at any stage in the workflow to show status or summarize forms with funds to be submitted to the region.”

Builders are able to complete the necessary forms from their workspace 24/7, no longer having to visit a local municipal office during core hours. “The implementation of the Web-based technology has allowed for easy access by developers, as well as secured access to Local and Regional staff from any work location to complete the form(s),” said Don Beaton, the Region of Durham’s Director, Financial Information Management Services. “The electronic flow of information allows for faster and more accurate information flow.”

The Region’s application process involved a six-layered approach to workflow, with the ability to progress or retract a particular form to any level in the workflow at any given time. With the complexity of this workflow process and the importance of both data integrity and security, the initial development effort was completed using custom Microsoft .NET development. By leveraging the Microsoft platform, OnX was able to develop the application in a reduced timeframe and provide a more cost-effective solution to Durham. OnX is also promoting the additional use of Microsoft and ISV products including Reporting Services, Analysis Services, K2, Infopath and the Microsoft Office 2007 suite.

The return on investment was a major driver for initiating a second phase to the project, extending the solution. The direction for Phase II of this workflow process will introduce either BizTalk or Windows Workflow.

“The implementation of the electronic application has provided for improved service to businesses, and time and resource efficiencies for the Regional Municipality of Durham and the eight lower-tier governments involved in the process,” said Don Beaton. “This implementation met several of the region’s Community Strategic Plan initiatives through leading the development of more cooperation among government bodies and other service providers within the region and pursuing opportunities to streamline the delivery of municipal government services.”
